

## Town of Groton – Road Committee Minutes

August 14, 2018

Meeting called to order 7:20 pm.

In attendance: Tony Albert, Jeremy Haney, Robert Ellis, Ruth Millett, James Joyce & Anne Joyce.

Absent: Roger Thompson, Dan Tobine.

### **Update North Groton Road**

More than ½ of the ditching has been completed & the front of headers are now visible. First two culverts are done with two more to be completed on Wed. Aug 15<sup>th</sup>. Underdrain is done. The fourth 18-inch culvert was added near the corner to compensate for the other one on the other side being considerably higher. Reclaiming to be done Sept. 4-6 with paving to be completed Sept. 10-11. The road will have one lane of travel during these periods. The first two sections of paving that was previously done by Helen Santoro on North Groton Road are lifting causing salt water to seep into it. While the keyway machine is in town, a keyway will be cut between the old previously paved pavement by Helen Santoro & paved to correct this. The seal cracks that were previously repaired will also be corrected. Cost is \$250.00 per spot.

### **Sculptured Rocks Road**

No FEMA totals quoted or received. Guesstimate of damage is approximately \$300,000. Part of the road was floating, undermined, washed out in parts, sides of the road washed out & pot holes. Moisture in the winter will continue seeping in undermining the road. Something needs to be done either using ultra high-performance cold patch (UPM) or grinding spreading & compacting the flat portions of the approximate four miles of road. One-inch ledge pack has been spread around Hammer Head Lane.

### **Province Road**

FEMA money received in the amount of \$41,000 from the July storm. Money must be spent this year. Robert Ellis reached out to contractors to use these funds. Fourteen culverts need to be replaced which the town will supply. How much ditching & yards of material can be completed to allow this road to be passable for a two-wheel drive vehicle. Work on this road would need to be completed by Oct 31, 2018.

### **Edgar Albert Road**

The road was York raked & material spread. The road is in decent shape.

### **Bailey Hill Road-town portion**

Road needs to be York raked, smoothed out with material.

### **Fletcher Road**

Is in ok shape, time is running short this year.
